

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR
ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS FOR
FALKIRK STREET AND CROSSGATE ROAD

THE CITY OF PORT WENTWORTH

Sealed bids will be received by THE CITY OF PORT WENTWORTH at 305 South Coastal Highway, Port Wentworth, Georgia, until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **Tuesday, April 12, 2016** at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of roadway Improvements for Falkirk Street (0.26 miles) and roadway Improvements for Crossgate Road (0.35 miles). More specifically the improvements include the asphalt overlay and roadway patching.

Bids for the complete work in one or more general contracts shall be made on the bid form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid. All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of the City of Port Wentworth, in the amount of at least five percent (5%) of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for the City of Port Wentworth. Each bond shall be equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the City of Port Wentworth as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within ten (10) days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.
